Scope and Application

<u>Purpose:</u> The intent in defining pet sheltering capabilities is to assist agencies in better understanding the kinds and quantities of resources necessary to deliver pet sheltering services at the level required to meet the needs of the community. This will promote the collaboration of National, State, Regional and Local VOADs and federal, state, tribal, & local emergency management agencies during all phases of disasters.

<u>Scope.</u> The scope of this document is limited. The focus of the information is on the kinds and quantities of resources (personnel, supplies & equipment) required to establish and manage a temporary shelter for the safe and humane handling, care and housing of companion animals, including pets, service animals and assistance animals as well as livestock.

The document identifies quantities of supplies and equipment required for the initial 7 days for 3 sizes of shelters (500, 300 or 100 animals) with a fixed percentage of animal species. The expectation is that this would provide the Pet Sheltering Team with enough resources to start and that additional resources would be ordered once capabilities of the facility and the exact composition of the sheltered animals is known.

Intended Audience. The intended audience of this document includes National, State, Regional, and Local VOADs and federal, state, tribal, & local emergency management agencies with pet sheltering responsibilities in the event of a disaster.

<u>Definitions.</u> In this document capability is defined as the ability to deliver a service with the kinds of available resources. Capacity is defined as the level of service that can be delivered with the quantities of available resources. The National Incident Management System (NIMS) defines resources, as "Personnel, equipment, teams, supplies, and facilities available or potentially available for assignment to incident operations and for which status is maintained."

<u>Co-located sheltering</u>: Animal and people living spaces are separate. Owners may or may not participate in care. If owners are NOT participating in care, animal care staffing needs increase.

Cohabitated sheltering: Animals are living with their people in an emergency shelter.

Facility Notes

<u>General</u>. Churches or schools are not good candidates for pet and animal shelter facilities as they will return to their original function after a disaster much quicker than other facilities and sheltered animals may need to remain in a shelter longer than their owners stay in a public shelter.

<u>Pet & companion animals.</u> For Co-located shelters, assuming 500 animals, 75-100 sq. ft. per animal would be ideal. For Cohabitated shelters, 50-75 sq. ft. per person/animal. With multi-pet/multi species households, space requirements increase.

<u>Segregation for only cat/only dog.</u> This would include a small-animal room where all animals are placed up off the floor and the temperature is regulated.

<u>Livestock.</u> Horse stalls are generally 10x10 up to 12x12 in facilities. In some cases, two horses may be stalled together if they are "buddies" already. Ideally, solid walls between stalls is better than metal panels. Horses are big on "pecking order" fighting.

For small livestock, most horse panels won't hold small livestock (they can go under or through), so the panels or pens needed are different. Use stalls of 6x6 or 8x8 for goats, sheep, or swine, and put multiples in one pen if they are already from the same herd. Llamas and alpacas typically need 8x8 and larger. Solid walls between pens is great, but if it isn't already there, you can't build it. If separate all-portable pens are used, double the number of panels are needed.

Care Ratios

Care ratios increase with the increased length of care, and are dependent on species, size, space, etc. These ratios below are ONLY for a co-located shelter where owners are NOT participating daily care. These staff are for feeding and cleaning of the animals and are in addition to veterinary specialists or shelter management.

Generically:

- Dogs/Cats: 2 persons per 25-35 animals
- Pocket Pets/Small Animals: 2 persons per 50 animals
- Horses: 2 persons per 10-20 head of horse
- Farm Animals/Fowl: 2 persons for every 50 animals
